- Has someone prevented you from accessing basic necessities?
- Has someone threatened, intimidated or harassed you?
- Has someone hurt you or told you that they were going to hurt you?
- Are you being wrongfully evicted?
- Has someone taken financial advantage of you (used your money or property without your permission)?
- Has someone stolen your identity, money or property?
- Do you have a guardian or is someone trying to become your guardian when you can still make your own decisions?
- Is your Power of Attorney misusing your money?
- Has anyone tried to stop you from reaching out for help?
